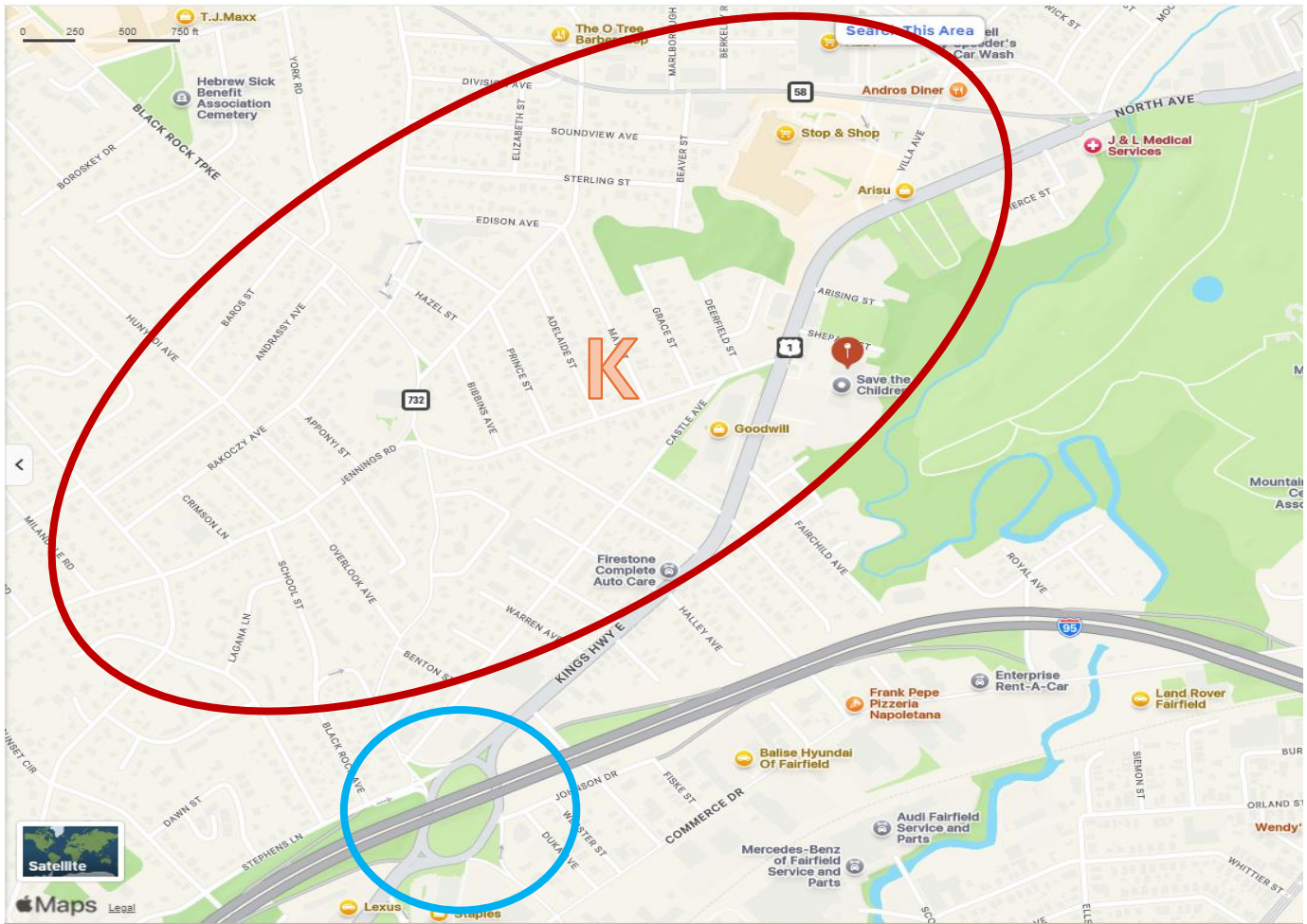


## The Next Street, Fairfield, CT Testing area



### Address:

### 501 Kings Highway East (Save the Children building)

Applicants need to report to the office located on the Second Floor, Ste. 201, to check in for their testing appointment. After checking in, students will typically start their test from the front of the building.

### Primary testing area (inside the RED oval):

### Potential Routes:

1. Left turn out of the main building driveway, heading south on Kings Highway, passing Miller Nissan, staying to the Right, proceeding to the right up Black Rock Turnpike to the traffic light at the top of the hill. Turn right onto Jennings Rd. Possible 3-Point (K) turn on a side street – not all side streets have Stop signs at their end; these are “implied stops”. Return to starting point. Parking done in building parking lot.
2. Right turn out of the main building driveway, heading north on Kings Highway, turn Left onto Villa Ave. Possible parking in Stop & Shop parking lot. Be careful of islands (stay to the right of these) & Stop signs or lack of stop signs (Right of Way). Parking space lines are double lines. Exit from parking lot/shopping center & turn right onto Tunxis Hill Rd. There are potentially TWO traffic lights

the students will come to, making a Right turn to return to the office. Be aware of lane changes, lane positioning, and all traffic controls.

3. **TRICKY! (inside BLUE circle)**- Left turn out of the main building driveway, heading south on Kings Highway, passing Miller Nissan, staying to the LEFT (watch all traffic controls). This route requires strictly following the traffic controls and lane positioning, navigating around the traffic circle. Applicants must be in the correct lane at the correct time, using turn signals as required. Return to office for parking in the main parking lot; side streets from Kings Highway can be used for 3-Point (K) turns and/or parallel parking.

**Beware of:**

- Making proper left turns – closest lane first (right side of the island or yellow line), then signal and move to the right travel lane
- No Left turn signs
- No Turn on Red signs
- Speed limit on Kings Highway is 35 mph. Back and other side streets are 25 mph
- Many side streets **Do Not** have a stop sign at the end of the particular street – this is an implied stop & applicants must come to a complete stop before proceeding onto the main street
